An extended abstract must include all 5 sections listed in this document (Introduction, Objective, Data/Methodology, Results/Findings, Implications for Research/Policy). All tables and figures should be cited in numerical order with the following format: **Fig. #** and **Table #**. The text should use the Times New Roman font with the size of 12.
